- Dispute a decision of an umpire (1 Match)
- Use of Obscene gesture (1 Match)

Intentionally / Carelessly:

- Striking another person (MINOR) (2 Matches)
- Tripping another person whether by hand, arm, foot or leg (2 Matches)
- Engages in time wasting (1 Match)
- Charging another person (2 Matches)
- Throwing or pushing another Player after the Player has taken a Mark, disposed of the football or after the football is otherwise out of play (2 Matches)
- Engaging in rough conduct against an opponent which in the circumstances is unreasonable (2 matches)
- Engaging a melee, except where a Player's
