East Sunbury Coach Explains Shock Decision

A CANDID Steve Grey says off-field issues triggered his shock resignation as East Sunbury coach.

The Thunder sits on top of the ladder with a 7-2 record, but the outgoing mentor declared the Strathmore Community Bank Division 2 club's "culture has to change".

Grey was in his fourth season at the helm and told president Keith Osborne of his decision to quit on Monday before addressing East Sunbury's players last night.

"I'm always having people look over my shoulder, watching what I'm doing, who I'm picking and people are asking questions about why I'm doing this or doing that instead of having the trust in what I'm doing." Grey said.

"It's probably in my best interests, where I can set my future up, because I can't see any structure moving forward with the club.

"What's our goal in the next 2-3 years? They're all just worried about in the moment.

"Too many people have got too many things to say instead of having one leader at the top and everyone work as a team. It's more like individuals just having their input.

"I've got no grudges against anyone, it's just the way the football club is at the moment."

East Sunbury is chasing a maiden finals appearance in its sixth season in the EDFL senior ranks.

The ladder-leader lost by 109 points against Northern Saints on Saturday, but that defeat had no bearing on Grey's call.

Grey said he had no issues with the club's playing group but conceded "there will be a few players pretty happy I've gone".

He had become increasingly frustrated by questions over his decisions given the Thunder's progress on the field.

"I started with a club that was getting beaten by 150 points each week and have turned it around now in three and a half of years," Grey said.

Osborne said he was blindsided by Grey's decision with East Sunbury in premiership contention.

A four-man coaching panel comprising Darrell Cartwright, Jason Spiteri, Anthony Galea and Darren Bird will steer the senior side for the next two weeks, with the club looking to have an interim coach for the remainder of the season appointed before its Round 14 clash with Coburg Districts on July 7.

"Massive shock for myself. I didn't see this coming at all," Osborne said

"Steve's not only been a great head coach, he's a great clubman.
"The big story is we've lost a senior coach, but the bigger story for our club is we've lost a better clubman.

"I don't know how many senior coaches are marking lines on a Thursday night."

Osborne said the Thunder was determined not to let Grey's departure impact its premiership quest.

"We don't want this to uproot an entire club," he said.

"The game plan hasn't changed for us. We think we're a top-four side and will play finals this year and hopefully go deep into finals." Grey said he wanted to coach again and would assess his options in coming weeks.

East Sunbury will tackle Roxburgh Park this weekend.

East Keilor Explains Grigg's Departure

EAST Keilor president Geoff Nicholl has denied claims the club is fractured in the wake of the departure of co-coach Nick Grigg.

The Cougars are languishing in seventh spot on the Essendon Ford Division 1 ladder after a disastrous 1-6 start to the season, with Grigg opting to cross to Riddell District league outfit Rupertswood.

Nicholl described the split as an "amicable agreement" after work commitments prevented Grigg from training.

Grigg made four appearances for East Keilor this year and was in his second season as co-coach alongside Ash Arrowsmith, who will lead the club solo for the remainder of 2018.

The loss also hurts the Cougars on-field after Grigg kicked 48 goals last season.

"We gave him some time off to think about things and see what he wanted to do and he came back and said it's probably best if we part," Nicholl said.

"It's been a tough week. It's not often you get a coach wanting to leave only halfway through a season.

"That was a bit disappointing and I think Nick felt he was letting the side down by not being there and not training.

"I did give him the opportunity of alternative training during the day. I think he felt it was time to move on. I can understand that.

"He's not disgruntled with the club, but I think he might be a bit disheartened by himself not being able to commit."

Grigg's situation also triggered rumours of disharmony at the club after a turbulent first half of the season.

"The club's going fine. Off the field is good and the committee has stuck together," Nicholl said

"There is no grumblings in the committee, as has been reported on (online forum) Big Footy or anywhere else.

"Football is a funny game and things can change quickly. Hopefully the second half of the year things will pick up and we can go from there."

East Keilor was tipped as one of the big improvers this year after a fruitful off-season resulted in the acquisitions of Matthew Knight, Tom Gleeson (both Strathmore), Dion Hill (St Albans), David House (Sunbury Kangaroos), Tom Madden (St Bernard's), Michael Licciardo (Melton), Nathan Kennedy, Dimitrios Guicas (both Taylors Lakes) and James Philipot (Broadford).

But the Cougars are carrying a long injury list, their sole win coming by two points against Jacana in Round 5.

Five of their six defeats have been by 17 points or less.

"We've actually got 14 senior players out. That's a big dent to any side," Nicholl said.

"Hopefully we can turn it around in the next few games and get a few back from injury the next few weeks.

"The competition is very tight ... with those margins, there's not much in it."

Preview | Strathmore Community Bank Premier Division

AVONDALE HEIGHTS v KEILOR

A MONTH ago, we were seriously considering this for *EDFL Match of the Day.*

But now, it seems we have a clear favourite.

Some of us were quick to dismiss Keilor as a serious Strathmore Community Bank Premier Division contender after several key players went down with injury.

The Blues' depth has been put to the test of late, and they've passed with flying colours.

But it helps to have the likes of Kane Barbuto, Dean Galea, Josh Martin and Matt Clarke at your disposal.

Mick McGuane's men have proven they'll be just fine as they slowly re-assemble their best 22, and by banking more wins in games like this, they should be back playing finals in 2018.

Avondale Heights scored a very good win in Round 8 over West Coburg.

Unavailability has also tested Donald McDonald in his first full year in charge at Canning Street and to come away from Coburg City Oval with a 29-point win was crucial in Heights' fight to avoid relegation.

Team selection could be telling in the lead-up, but Keilor should be feeling good about this one.

STRATHMORE v ABERFELDIE

Strathmore has quietly strung three straight wins together, albeit against bottom four sides.

The Mores are sitting at 5-3 and will be grateful to be ahead of the win-loss ledger, because their next five games are all against current top five sides – and Keilor (on Good Friday) is the only one they have managed to beat to date.

Nathan Grima's plan to introduce the next crop of Strathmore stars has worked pretty well, but with Jaryd Cachia due back from suspension and Hamish McIntosh now back out on the park, we might start to see the Mores make their move up the ladder in the second half of the season.

Aberfeldie at Lebanon Reserve presents a tricky test here, though.

The smaller confines of Lebanon may better suit what has been an outstanding Aberfeldie defensive unit of late.

Aberfeldie has conceded no more than 12 goals in any game so far this year and was successful in shutting down Maribymong Park in a low-scoring slog in Round 8.

Don't expect this to be a shoot-out.

PASCOE VALE v WEST COBURG

Expect this to be a shoot-out.

Pascoe Vale is the second highest-scoring team in Strathmore Community Bank Premier Division (behind only Keilor), and yet still finds itself outside the top four.

Since the calendar turned to May, Mathew Watson has been

unstoppable in front of goal, with 26 goals from his last four games.

Jacob Polizzi and Lachie Hansen have been a fine supporting cast as the Panthers have mounted an impressive four-game winning streak.

Defensively, the back line has quietly been doing its job, too, with Luke Foster putting together another very good season.

If the back line holds true then West Coburg will struggle to keep up with the Panthers, because you know the home team will be keen for another big day up forward.

The Burgers need to be willing to take the game on through the middle and use their pace going into attack for four quarters to be a chance in this one.

MARIBYRNONG PARK v GLENROY

The Queen's Birthday break came at a perfect time for Maribymong Park.

The Lions dropped consecutive games to Greenvale and Aberfeldie after a hot 6-0 start to the year – giving coach Robbie Castello a chance to assess where his team needs to lift ahead of the second half of the season.

Coming up against a battling Glenroy outfit, this might be the Lions' chance to run themselves back into some form.





The young playing group has started to gel, with the likes of Josh Hale matching it with the top players.


Once the Tigers get a bit more consistency, expect to see them get a few more wins and maybe sneak into the top four.


