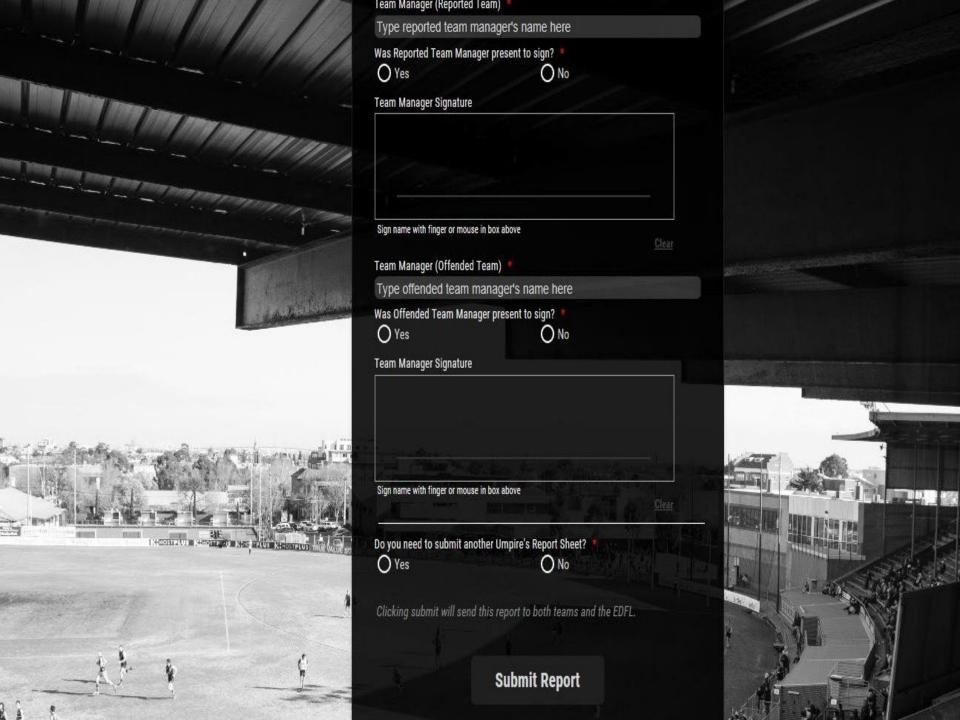






Type in the Team Managers (Representatives) Name. (Not Coach)
