Umpire Observer

Role:

The Umpire Observer is to be a leader who has the ability to create a positive learning environment and facilitate the improvement of on-field umpiring performance.

The main function is to provide feedback to umpires within the EDFL and assist in their assessment and progression.

The occupant of this position is responsible to the Umpires Coordinator.

The specific duties associated with the positions are as follows:-

- Observe umpires in matches and provide constructive and positive feedback to assist with their development and progression. This may include a written or verbal summary of their umpiring performance.
- Be approachable and available by listening to umpires and providing guidance.
- Complete the authorised Coaches course conducted by AFL Victoria within a time frame agreed.
- Respect and abide by the rules and by-laws of the E.D.F.L. and the Umpires Code of Conduct.
